Note: recommended limits have been indicated for most items. However, an additional quantity may be supplied in a small number of cases where the degree of incontinence is shown to require more than the indicated limits. In these situations, the prescriber will need to seek prior approval from DVA.

After the first request by the prescriber, the prescribed products can be ordered as required by the entitled person e.g. any amount up to 3 month supply of disposable pads.

AD01	Draw Sheet - Absorbent, Waterproof Backing	Limit of 4 for management of incontinence. Replacement after a 1 year period.
AD02	Disposable Liners/Underpads (blue underlay)	Limit of 600 every 3 months.
AD03	Catheter Drainage Bag (non-sterile/sterile) non-drainable	Limit of up to 96 every 3 months.
AD04	Urinal (male and female)	Limit of 1 per person.
AD05	Catheters - In-Dwelling (e.g. Foley)	Limit up to 2 per month. Initially by LMO, S, CA and subsequent request for supplies can be made by RN or entitled person.
AD06	Continence Briefs long lasting	Limit of 5 every 3 months for the longer lasting, reusable more expensive briefs.
AD07	Continence Pads - Disposable	Limit of 540 disposable pads every 3 months. 'Pull-ups' are considered to be pads and therefore the limit of 540 every 3 months apply.
AD08	Urine Drainage Bottle - 4 litres (with connecting tubing)	Limit of 2 per year
AD09	Leg Bag (non-sterile/sterile)	Limit of 18 non-sterile bags or 18 sterile bags every 3 months.
AD10	Penile Clamp	Limit of 2 per year.
AD11	Catheters - intermittent (e.g. Nelaton)	Subsequent request for supplies can be made by RN or entitled person. Limit of 32 per month.
AD12	Catheters - External (e.g. unidome/penile sheath/penile pouch)	Limit of 120 every 3 months.
AD13	Urine Collection Bag Hanger	Limit of 1 per person.
AD14	Waterproof Sheet (rubberised)	Limit of 2 per person. Replacement after a 1 year period.
AD15	Continence Consumables	Limited to products on suppliers contract. Includes sterile gloves, KY Jelly, sterilising agents, tubing and perineal/stoma cleansing products.
AD16	Occlusive Devices (e.g. anal plugs)	Limit of 105 every 3 months.
AD17	Sitz Bath	Limit of 1 per person.
AD18	Faecal Collector - Perianal	Limit of 120 every 3 months.
AD19	Continence Briefs - short term	Stretch, mesh, disposable briefs. Limit of 8 per month.
AD20	Pessary ring	Limit of 1 per year. Initially by LMO, S, and subsequent requests for supplies can be made by RN, CA or entitled person.
AD21	Continence Pads - Re-usable/Washable	Limit of 18 washable/re-usable pads every 3 months. 'Pull-ups' are considered to be pads and therefore ADO7 limits apply.
AD22	Catheter Drainage Bag (non-sterile/sterile) - Drainable	Limit of 18 bags every 3 months.
AD23	Catheter valves - Long Term	Limit of 4 per year.
AD24	Chair pads - waterproof	Limit of 2 per year.
AD25	Catheter valves - short term	Limit of 18 every 3 months.
