### Getting Ready for the NDIS

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is running information sessions for people with disability, family members and carers to help them understand NDIS processes. These sessions are for people who currently receive funding under the Futures for Young Adults program and/or an Individual Support Package. In these sessions we will:

- provide an overview of the NDIS and explain how the NDIS works;
- describe the pathway into the NDIS and the rollout in the Hume and Moreland areas; and
